October 6th: 2 am - Early wakeup call and checkout as you will depart the hotel in Cape Town at 3:30 for SA 306 departing CPT Airport at 7 am. Upon arrival at VFA on SA 040 in VFA at 8:55 am, go through immigration and pay \$30 US for arrival visa, claim your luggage and you will be met by our Zimbabwean Tour Guide and transferred to the Elephant Hills Hotel & Resort. Free day and join us this evening for a - Sunset Cruise: Join us at the end of the day, sail upstream to celebrate the setting African Sun. Share in the end-of-day ritual which sees wild herds streaming to the river banks for their last drink. Flocks of birds skim the waterline as the sun sets behind the African skyline. Enjoy a range of cocktails served with an accompaniment of delectable hors d'oeuvres. Bring a camera and create your own golden memories. Return to the lodge around later that evening.

October 7th: 8:30 am - Tour of Victoria Falls: <u>Bring a rain jacket or umbrella.</u> Guests will be accompanied through the Rainforest by a qualified English Language Guide, who will give a brief history of the falls as well as detailing the flora, fauna, bird & wildlife and other points of interest.

The edge of the falls is reached through the cool, moist tunnels of the rainforest. Always shrouded in fine spray, the forest is a fairyland of exotic plants thriving in the humidity.

Parts of the precipice opposite the falls have been cleared of undergrowth to give a clear view, but the falls can also be seen from the depths of the forest through glistening, dripping, spray soaked leaves. Return to the lodge around 11 am.

October 8th: Free day after Breakfast to enjoy from a list of activities at the resort and surrounding area. This evening join us for our farewell dinner.

October 9th: Enjoy the morning with breakfast, settle your account and check-out. We depart at 11 am for our return flight via SA 041 at 1:30 pm, connecting to SA 203 from JNB to JFK. Arrival in New York at 6:40 am on 10 October.

Quick Facts

PASSPORT VALIDITY:

No minimum validity requirement, recommend validity at least 6 months after trip date

BLANK PASSPORT PAGES:

Recommend at least 2 blanks pages for Visa upon arrival.

TOURIST VISA REQUIRED:

Yes, to be obtained at the port of entry - airport (see below*)

VACCINATIONS:

Recommended Hepatitis A/B, Typhoid shots and Malaria Medication recommended. <u>Please check with</u> your medical professional specifically for your needs.

CURRENCY RESTRICTIONS FOR ENTRY:

None. The "official currency" is the US dollar. ATM's may not be available. Credit cards are accepted.

CURRENCY RESTRICTIONS FOR EXIT:

No more than \$5,000 U.S. equivalent

BRING BUG REPELLENT AND RAIN GEAR FOR THE TOUR OF THE FALLS, CRUISE AND AT NIGHTS

*You need a passport, visa, return ticket, and adequate funds to cover your intended stay in order to enter Zimbabwe. If you are traveling to Zimbabwe for tourism, business, or transit, you may obtain a visa at the airport or other border ports-of-entry. There is currently no option of getting a Zimbabwean tourist visa in advance through the Zimbabwean Embassy in Washington DC. You can expect to pay \$30 US for a 30-day/single-entry visa or \$60 USD for a 60-day/multiple entry visa. Extensions are possible, and require visiting the Zimbabwe Immigration Office's public window. Travelers who intend to engage in any non-tourism related activity require a visa in advance of entry. Contact the Department of Immigration Zimbabwe for further details and information on other types of visas and entry permits.
